

How much does it cost to make a lasting power of attorney?

Individuals:

A single power of attorney for one person is £400 plus VAT at 20% and a court fee of £82.

total **£562**

Both powers of attorney for one person is £700 plus VAT at 20 % and two court fees.

total **£1004**

Couples:

A single power of attorney each for a couple is £700 plus VAT at 20% and two court fees.

total **£1004**

Both powers of attorney for a couple is £1,200 plus VAT at 20 % and four court fees.

total **£1768**

All our fees are based on registering the powers at the outset however if you wish to proceed without registration we will provide a revised cost quote

What are the two types of power of attorney?

Property and Finances:

This enables your attorney(s) to make decisions about financial matters, i.e. your money and your property and how your financial affairs should be managed.

Health and Welfare:

This enables your attorney(s) to make decisions about matters relating to your healthcare and welfare issues.

Home visits:

We are happy to undertake home visits for those unable to attend the office. However, we make a charge of £100.00 plus VAT at 20% per hour for travelling time and in addition 45p per mile travelled plus VAT at 20% to cover fuel costs.

Court fee

The Maximum fee is £82.00 per document. However, if you are in receipt of a qualifying benefit you are entitled to a fee exemption. If you are not in receipt of a qualifying benefit but your gross annual income is less than £12,000 per year you will be eligible for a 50% reduction of the fee.

Qualifying Benefits include Pension Credit, Housing Benefit and Council Tax Benefit.
